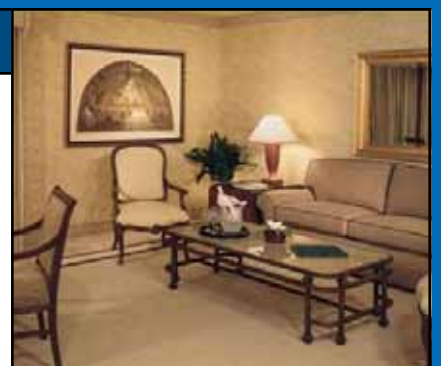

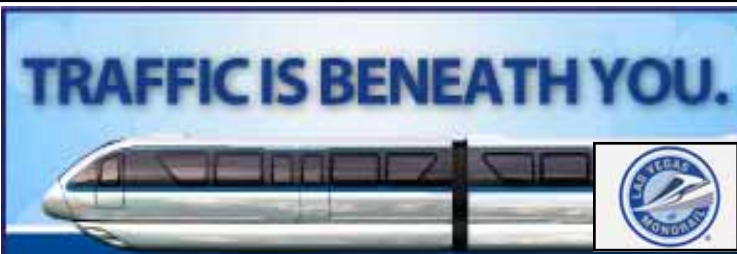


THE DUECE

THE MONORAIL
